

**New Testament Church of Milwaukee

2017 Student of the Year Scholarship Application**

The New Testament Church Education/Scholarship Ministry was founded to promote and encourage excellence in education and to rely heavily on the wisdom of God (Proverbs 2:6). A \$1500.00 Student of the Year Scholarship is given annually to at least one New Testament Church student to recognize and reward his/her academic excellence, ministry service, high school activity and community service. Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the scholarship:

Applicant Criteria

The applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the spring semester of 2017.

The applicant or his or her parent(s)/guardian(s) must be members of New Testament Church.

The applicant must be actively involved in at least one New Testament Church ministry.

The applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (B average) on a 4.0 scale or better for the previous 7 semesters prior to graduation.

The applicant must submit all of the following materials:

- Student of the Year Application Forms
 - Personal Information Form (Page 2)
 - Extra-Curricular Activities Form (Pages 3 & 4)

- Letter of Recommendation/Testimonial (Addressed to New Testament Church Education/Scholarship Ministry) from each of the following:
 - Ministry Service Leader
 - High School Activity Advisor
 - Community Service Facilitator

- 2-Page Scriptural Leadership Essay & Cover Sheet (Page 5)

- Official High School Transcript (**SEALED**)

A Student Applicant Rating Form is included (Page 6) so all students understand how the Education/Scholarship Committee evaluates/ranks each applicant.

Scriptural Leadership Essay Topic and Guidelines

When you go to college, your days will be filled with classes, studying, hanging out with like-minded friends, and participating in student activities. Your life as a college student will be quite busy!

The goals at New Testament Church of Milwaukee during 2017 is *“To strengthen our faith by practicing the 4 continuing activities of the early church: Bible study, fellowship, the Lord’s Supper, and prayers. (Acts 2:42)”*

After meditating on Acts 2:42 and taking into consideration the teachings at New Testament Church (including the lessons learned about strengthen our faith), write an essay with a focus on the following question:

- How do you plan to apply the lessons about *Strengthen your Faith* to your life as a busy college student?

Note: You may include any additional scriptures to support your answer.

Guidelines and Criteria

The guidelines and criteria listed below will be used to evaluate your essay.

- Demonstrated understanding of the Bible verses and essay topic listed in essay prompt
- 2-pages typed
- APA-format (1” margins, 12-point font, double-spaced, and proper documentation of citations)
- Well-organized essay
- Mechanics of the essay (i.e. capitalization, grammar, spelling, and punctuation)
- Inclusion of scriptural references and citations
- Cover Sheet - Please include your name on your Leadership Essay “Cover Sheet” ONLY!

Graduate Recognition Ceremony Essay Reading:

The Student of the Year Scholarship award recipient(s) will be asked to read his or her essay(s) in the sanctuary during the Graduate Recognition Ceremony on Sunday, June 25, 2017. We encourage all applicants to practice reading their essay. Participation in the ceremony is required unless there is a legitimate excuse (such as required attendance at a pre-college summer program) that is accepted by the New Testament Church Education/Scholarship Committee.
