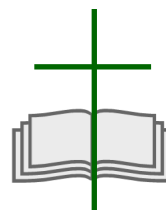

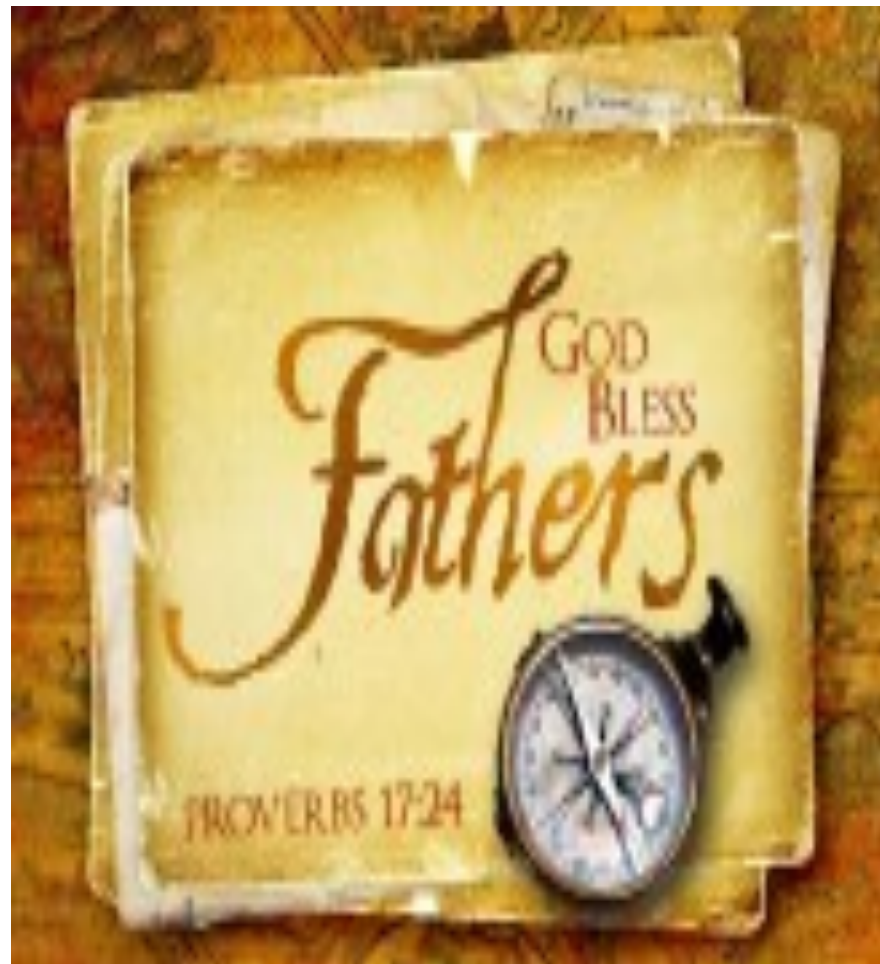

Some Characteristics of Carnal Christians

A carnal Christian is a Christian who is indwelt with the Holy Spirit but not filled with the Holy Spirit. The members of the church at Corinth were saved and indwelt with the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 1:2; 6:9-11, 19). We know that the church at Corinth was not filled with the Holy Spirit because the filling of the Holy Spirit produces the fruit of the Holy Spirit, and the first fruit on the list is love (Galatians 5:22). We know that love was missing in the church at Corinth because Paul devoted 1 Corinthians 13 to love.

Paul lists three characteristics of carnal Christians in 1 Corinthians 3:1-9: First, carnal Christians are babes in Christ – they are immature (vv. 1-2; cf. 2 Peter 3:18). Second, carnal Christians manifest the works of the flesh (v. 3; cf. Galatians 5:19-21). Third, carnal Christians focus on personalities rather than on Christ (vv. 4-9). All believers are commanded to be filled with the Holy Spirit moment-by-moment.

One of the requirements for the filling of the Holy Spirit is obedience. Let us pray that God will give us the grace to trust and obey Him at all times and in all things.

Let us stand on these words: “Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths” (Proverbs 3:5-6). “His mother said to the servants, ‘Whatever He says to you, do it’” (John 2:5, NKJV).
